Jointly produced by the NUS Department of Real Estate and the NUS Institute of Real Estate

Studies, the book: "Singapore's Real Estate: 50 Years of Transformation", was part of efforts in commemorating Singapore's 50 years of nation building.

The editorial team commenced brainstorming and conceptualizing the book outline as early as August 2014. The underlying principle centres on the need for a book that will prove as a useful reference for people to learn and appreciate the various thought processes, motivations and influencing factors that shaped the real estate market in Singapore. The team leveraged on the valuable resources of some very experienced and influential thought-leaders in Singapore's real estate industry, and through structured interview processes, it was able to draw on their reservoir of knowledge.

This book was intended not just as a comprehensive reference that reflected past developments, but also documented learning points that would prove useful in guiding the growth of Singapore's real estate market over the next 50 years and beyond.
